# Curriculum Begins 9/20

Below you will find the age groupings as well as a description of the curriculum provided. Please let us know if you feel your child would be better suited in another age group. Each child's needs are different and we want to make sure they are in a class that is best for them. Our teachers may make a suggestion also. Our goal is for children to be comfortable and excited about going to Sunday School each week.

**Nursery** A quiet, safe place for children infant to 2 years old.

**Preschool:** Children ages 3-4 will be read a short Bible story and then make a craft item, followed by play time.

**Elementary: K-1 and 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Workshop Rotation**

Last October we introduced the workshop rotation program for elementary students and both teachers and students liked it. We decided to continue with the program for K-1 and 2-6 grades. On 9/20 we will begin workshops on Plagues and Passover. Remember, the workshop rotation program teaches the same Bible story for 4 or more Sundays using medium like cooking, crafts, games, movies, drama and computers.

**7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Bible Lessons for Youth**

This curriculum applies the Bible to real-life issues that teens face in the secular world. Lesson material is presented with modern cutting-edge graphics that capture teen attention. Interesting class activities stimulate teens to conduct self-examination, think about serious issues, make value judgments, and apply Biblical principles to real-world situations.

## Workshop Curriculum for Plagues and Passover

**Cyber Bible:** View animated story of Moses and Pharaoh. Learn about the heroines of the Exodus story. Make your own Haggadah.

**Eat Your Way through the Bible:** A simple Seder meal will be prepared and shared by the class.

**Mary & Martha's B&B:** Two storytellers, Shiphrah and Puah, tell their story of the genocide of the Hebrew baby boys, their relationship with God and the salvation of Moses. Make a basket to remember both the salvation of Moses and the people of Israel.

**Moved by the Spirit:** Playing games like Plaguescotch, Pharaoh May I, and Leapfrog (Passover), learn about how God convinced Pharaoh to free the Hebrew slaves. Create a reenactment of the crossing of the Red Sea.
