Dear Franklin United Methodist Church members and friends,

For over 150 years, The Franklin United Methodist Church has been a place where people have gathered to nurture a meaningful relationship with God, grow in Christ, and reach out in concern to others. Reaching out in concern currently includes hosting Meals on Wheels' food distribution, coordinating clothing donations for migrants in Franklin, housing the Aprende Spanish Immersion school, and supporting the Franklin Food Pantry, just to name a few.

Our current capital campaign, "Defining our Generation," seeks to support our ministries above and expand our positive impact in the community. In order to do this, four main areas of work are targeted:

- 1. Sanctuary renovation (ceiling repair, floor repair, organ protection).
- 2. Exterior building restoration (stain exterior siding, repair/paint molding and trim).
- 3. HVAC and Air Quality (updated HVAC, lower-level dehumidify and improve fresh air flow).
- 4. Increase the Endowment.

To achieve these four targeted areas of work, our capital campaign goal is set at \$300,000, sizeable but achievable.

Included with this letter is your commitment card. I would also encourage you to read the "Creative Strategies for Giving" brochure which is also included with this letter. It offers many ideas of ways to give that are outside the box of one's regular income. You may also find that our campaign prayer, "Lord, want do you want to do through me?", is helpful in your commitment decision-making.

We will be providing a special time in the worship service on March 24 for everyone to bring their commitment cards forward. Alternatively, you can use the return envelope provided to mail in your card.
