ABOUT THE FRANKLIN UMC

The Franklin United Methodist Church (UMC), located in Franklin, Massachusetts, has a rich history dating back to 1853 when the first Methodist class meeting was organized. These first gatherings of Methodists met in the Franklin Town Hall. The current facility, dedicated in 1873, has largely retained its original charm. The memorial stained glass windows were installed in 1903 and a pipe organ in 1905 adding to the church's beauty and historical significance. Additional classroom space and a kitchen were added in the 1930s.

Through its Community @FranklinUMC programs, the Franklin United Methodist Church seeks to build community by providing opportunities for neighbors to meet, serve, and share with one another. These interactions help forge the bonds of understanding and friendship, strengthening the foundations of the community.
